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The Ageing Process

With ageing, our skin changes under the influence of internal as well as external factors. Age, sex, temperature changes, sun exposure, medication etc. has a great influence on the condition of our skin. The result is a change in the appearance of the skin due to a reduced concentration of glucosaminoglycan or hyaluronic acid. The appearance of wrinkles and a loss of elasticity and tenacity become more obvious. Dehydration as we call it can not be compensated by the use of creams and our skin needs more help in order to look bright and shiny again.

Hyaluronic Acid

Hyaluronan is naturally found in many tissues of the body, such as skin, cartilage, and the vitreous humor. It is therefore well suited to biomedical applications targeting these tissues. In a normal skin, Hyaluronic Acid is an important substance in the extracellular matrix. It is responsible for the hydration of the extracellular matrix and makes new cell formation and migration possible.

Hyaluronic acid is a cross-linked product is mainly used in aesthetic procedures to fill wrinkles, is a non-crosslinked product it is mainly used in Mesotherapy procedures. R-fine® is one of the highest quality products available on the market today for Mesotherapy use.

R-fine®

R-fine® is a synthetically derived non-crosslinked Hyaluronic Acid for use in Mesolift procedures applied to the face, décolleté, neck and hands. The concentration is 1.5% or 15 mg/ml. R-fine® has a molecular weight of 2 million Daltons. Its protein content is the lowest in the market thereby reducing unwanted allergic reactions. R-fine® is one of the best free radical scavengers. The combination of all these features makes R-fine® the best option in Mesolift procedures.

Mesotherapy or Mesolift

Mesotherapy is a non-surgical medical cosmetic treatment. Mesotherapy is a medical specialty that involves injecting microscopic quantities of natural extracts, homeopathic agents, pharmaceuticals and vitamins into the skin. It can be used to eliminate cellulite, promote weight loss, treat ageing skin and redundant (sagging) skin, and rejuvenate the face, décolleté, hands and neck. It is only in the treatment of ageing skin where the term Mesolift is used, because the treatment gives a slight lifting effect.

Subdermal R-fine® injections rejuvenate the cells, making them more active, and thereby stimulating the production of collagen and elastin.

You can begin anti-ageing treatments in your mid twenties to prevent wrinkles from forming or at a later stage to treat the ageing signs.

Treatment

The protocol for your Mesolift procedure depends on the stage of ageing, your expectations and the specialist's possibilities. Initially your specialist will discuss your protocol in advance and may change it based on the outcome of each session.

In all cases, a Mesolift treatment consists of several treatments over a period of time. A minimum interval between two sessions is one week. Once good results are achieved, you do require maintenance sessions once every 6-12 months.

Technique

Your specialist will inform you about the technique he or she uses. Injections by hand or Mesogun are possible and depend on the experience and the indication of the area to treat. In general a few techniques are used: the linear threading or cross-hatching technique and the small puncture are the most common techniques used today. Ask your physician about his or her technique.

Side Effects

Since your skin is punctured by needles, there is a small chance of bruising and haematoma. Allergic reactions are very rare, but possible. Small bumps might be visible after injection, but disappear in due time.
